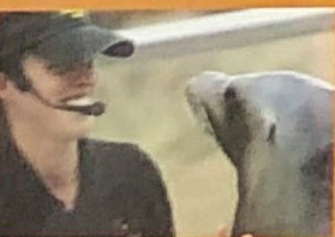

1875 Union Agency. Protecting the culture
and heritage of the 5 Tribes (Cherokee,
Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee (Creek)
and Seminole) through art and history.
The museum features arts shows, cultural
exhibits and a spring festival and tells the
story of the Indian removal. Handmade
gifts, jewelry, fine art and literature are
available in the Trading Post gift shop. Open
Mon-Fri, 10am-5pm and Sat 10am-2pm.

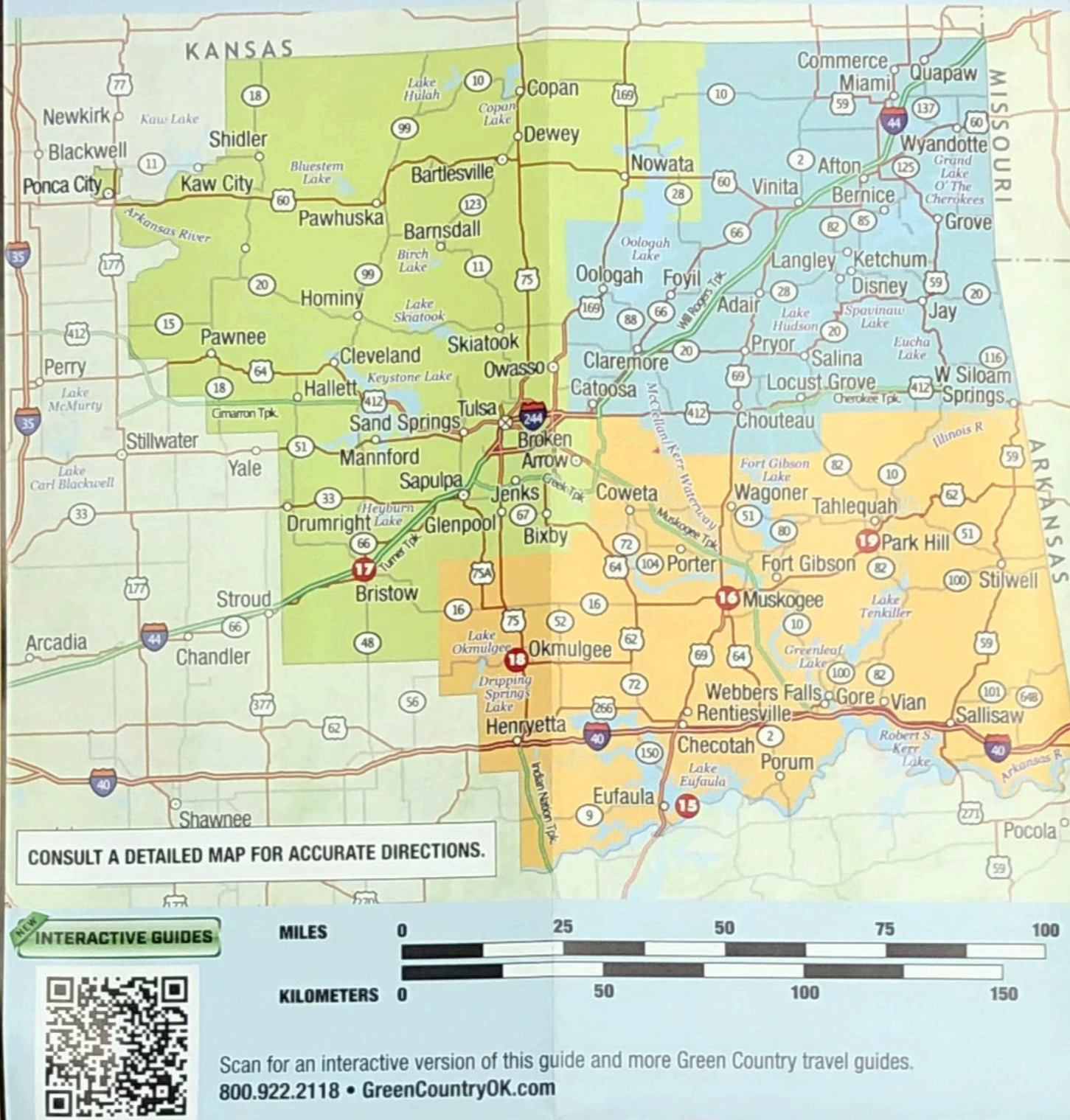

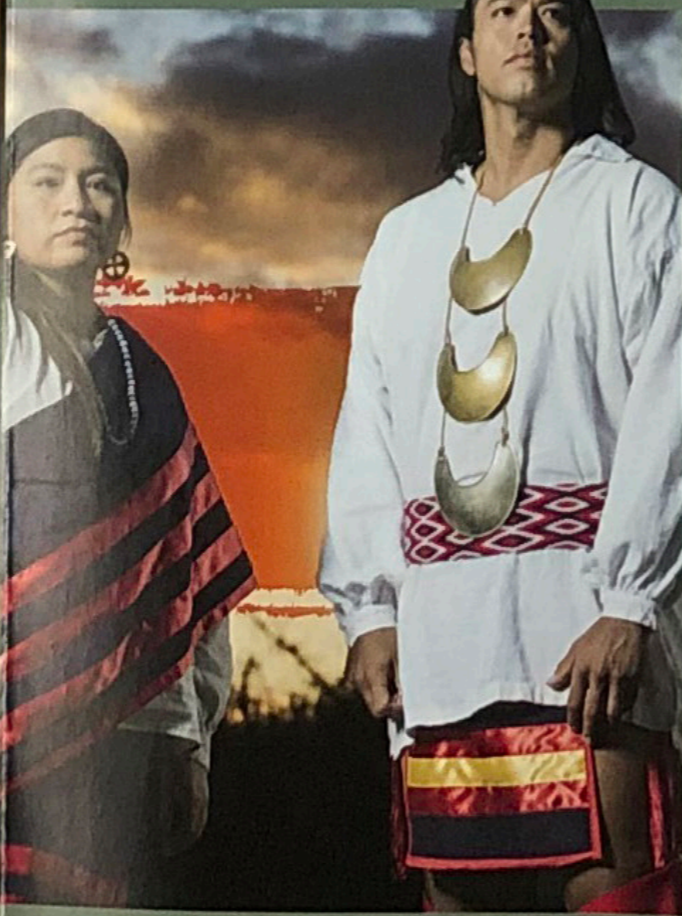

Honor Heights Park is home to the Pavilion
Teaching Garden and Georgia-Pacific
Butterfly House, the only enclosed butterfly
house in Oklahoma. In April, hundreds
of tulips fill the gardens along with the
park's Azalea Spring Bloom. Open daily

WAR MEMORIAL PARK & MILITARY MUSEUM

Open the hatches and prepare to dive at the
only submarine in the state of Oklahoma!
The USS Batfish, a preserved World War II
era submarine, holds an unbeatable record
of sinking three enemy submarines in
seventy-six hours. See military artifacts and
displays such as cannons, missiles, and
a self-propelled Howitzer. The park also
displays a piece of the USS Oklahoma, one
of the ships destroyed during the attack on
Pearl Harbor.

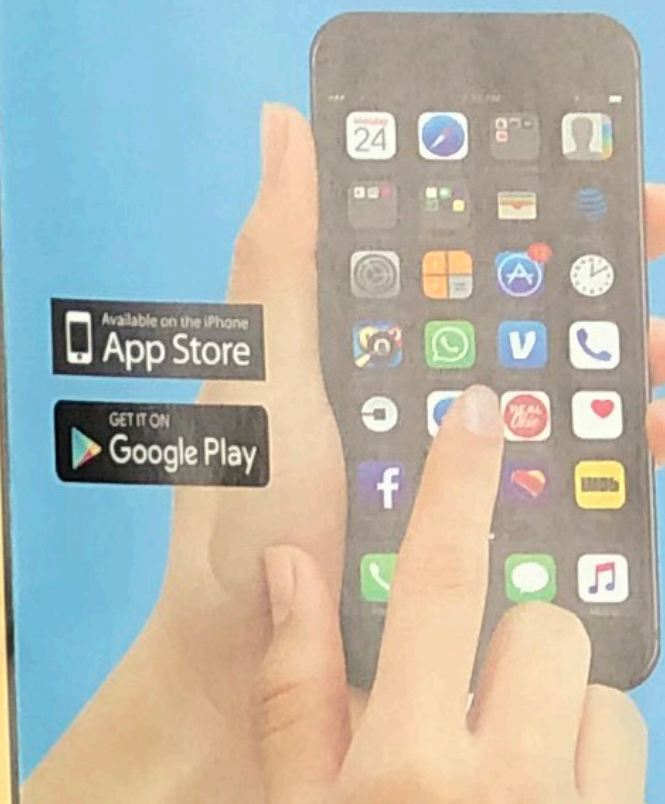
HUNTER'S HOME

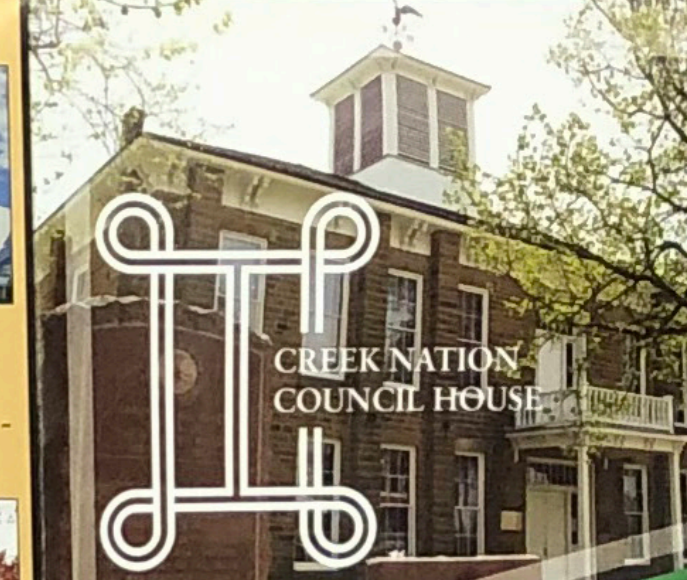
